Spectator Information - Safety Protocols for Xtream Arena / GreenState Family Fieldhouse: - All those over 2 years old must wear a mask in the building at all times, except while actively playing volleyball. Athletes are encouraged to keep the mask on during play, but it can be lowered during play. These rules are set by Xtream Arena and the mayor, so please adhere to the mask rules. Spectators are encouraged to sit 6 feet apart; there is plenty of room to spread out. **ALL spectators over the age of 2 must wear a mask at all times, inside the building.**

- Admission charge for all Adults and Seniors not listed on the roster - \$5
All Children 3 to 12 years old - \$3. Bleacher seating is available so no 'bag' chairs are allowed. No outside food or drink may be brought into the facility except players' water bottles.

- Per the Region, we will not be switching sides between sets, no hand shakes, etc.

- Players should stay in their own camps between matches and limit unnecessary contact with other teams.

-Game balls will be provided at each court.

Warm-Ups: Coaches START warm-ups immediately after previous match finishes. Each team's first match will be 10 mins (2 mins ball handling, 4 mins whole court for serving team, 4 mins whole court for receiving team). Subsequent matches will be 6 minute warm-ups (3 mins serving team, 3 mins receiving team). We will play ahead of schedule.

Pool Play: 2 sets to 25, starting at 4-4 win by 2. Finish placement will be determined by match winning percentage. Tie breaking criteria for 2 teams will be: head to head. Tie breaking criteria for 3 or more teams will be: point differential, coin flip. There will be no play-offs. An adult ref with a whistle must oversee the **match**.

Bracket Play: 2 out of 3 sets to 25 starting at 0-0. Deciding set to 15, no switching sides. Tournament champion will receive medals, a total of 10.

Concessions are available.. Do not bring in any outside food or drink, except your players' water bottle.

GreenState Fieldhouse opens at 7:45am. You MUST enter through the GreenState Family Fieldhouse entrance on the south side of the building. The

Xtream Arena entrance on the north side is locked. Parking is allowed on the street, on the southside of the Green State Fieldhouse entrance or at parking garage by the Marriot.
