- \* First place will receive medals.
- \* All teams will have a ten minute warm up (2 shared passing, 4 minutes serving team, followed by 4 minutes receiving) before their first match of the day. After everyone has their first playing match, each team will have 3 minutes of warm up (3 serving team team, 3 receiving team) no shared warm-up . If you are reffing this match, please keep track of the time, keep it to 6 min so we can keep the tourney **on schedule**.
- \* The tournament will play ahead once every team has played their first match. Be ready to play or ref when it's your teams turn.
- \* A coin toss will determine serve for each match.
- \* Bring marked balls for warm ups and use them in the gym only. Please provide team needs- whistles, pens, pencils, towels and medical supplies. Locker rooms are not available, but restrooms are.
- \* I do ask that when your team is officiating, an adult official is present. You are there as their coach to teach good officiating and to answer any questions they may have during a match, and to guide them.
- \* A concession stand will be available. Only water and Gatorade is allowed in gym. No Outside food is allowed in Complex, this is their policy and will be enforced
- \* And coaches, please have your team clean up their area before leaving. Thanks for your cooperation in advance. Bleacher seating is available. No lawn chairs. Heartland Complex charges an admission. It will be \$3/adult, \$2 students, under age 3 free. All coaches and players on Roster will not be charged. See you on the 13th. Any questions, please do not hesitate to call.
- \* I am sure it will be a fantastic day with lots of volleyball and smiles.
- \*The format can be played out many different ways, but this day will be a "first" for many coaches, players and parents. The times are approximate as

we want the players (coaches and parents) not to feel to rushed and want them to be able to ask questions.

\*we will be taking a break after the 11:50 game as everyone will be ready for a quick time out. Play will resume right after.
