Directions:

Hwy 20 to Peosta Exit

turn North onto Peosta St/CR-Y21

proceed through turning circle to Burds Rd on the Right (approx. 1 mi from exit), there is a small sign saying Comm Center before your turn

continue on Burds past school, Comm Center will be on your right

Admission is free to players and coaches (must be listed on roster);
\$2 Adults, \$1 Students and Preschool Fans are free

Play will begin at 8:30, gym opens at 7:45

All teams must check in with a printed up to date Webpoint roster, turned in prior to play at the check in desk.

Check in will be by the admission table. Results will be posted in team camp concessions room. We will play ahead please be aware of the court schedule to help facilitate a timely schedule.

Please note we will **NOT** hold a coaches meeting prior to start. Please address any questions regarding format, rules and judgement calls prior to your first match at the check in table.

Team Camp areas will be designated and in the same room as concessions and results to stay clear of the Community center members. No camps outside of that area. The walking track above the playing courts is reserved for Community Center members only!!

No coolers or outside food is allowed. A well stocked concessions stand will be available on site with breakfast, lunch, snacks and drinks available.

Chairs will be set up in the gym area for fans. Bag chairs will be allowed as well.

Good sportsmanship is expected and will be emphasized by all participants and spectators per USAV guidelines. Anyone choosing not to follow this rule will be asked to leave the facility.

Tournament Guidelines:

Warm up for each team's first match is 10 minutes (2 shared-4 serving team-4 receiving team). After each team's first match 3 serving – 3 receiving team format will be observed, no shared ball handling. No ball handling is permitted by teams not on the court. No shared hitting.

This is a 9 team 3 court tournament.

Round 1 and 2 Pool play will be 2 sets to 25 (starting at 4).

Since everyone is on the court all day we will take a ½ hour lunch break after Round 1. After Round 2 we will take a 15 minute break and move into bracket play

Team must have 2 participating adults on the officiating team – one as one of the referee positions (during pool play they may be standing beside the 1st referee and helping with a whistle) and one at the score table as either the scorekeeper, libero tracker or scoreboard.

Round 3:

- 3 1 seeds from Pools AA, BB, CC to the Gold Bracket
- 3 2 seeds from Pools AA, BB, CC to the Silver Bracket
- 3 3 seeds from Pools AA, BB, CC to the Bronze Bracket

Seeding will be determined by:

- (1) Set results from Round 2

Tie will be determined by

- 1) Results of the match between the tied teams, first on the won-lost record, and second on the point spread of the match
- 2) If still tied, comparison of the point differential based on the total round robin competition. Point differential should be determined by subtracting the total points gained by opponents from the total points earned by the team. The highest remainder should be considered the superior team for tie-breaking purposes.
- 3) If there is still a tie a single play off game to 15 will determine position.

Adult must R1 during tournament play.

Round 3 Tournament play 2 of 3 games to 25 (starting at 0), 3rd game to 15 if necessary. Must win by 2, no cap

Cell phones and electronic devices are *NOT* allowed at the scorer's table!!
