● 11-12s (Jan 21 & Jan 22 Teams)

- 1 & 2-day Tournament teams, registered with the Iowa Region as a qualifying series event as well for those teams potentially interested in being eligible to play in the Iowa Region Qualifier.
- 1 & 2-day teams will play against each other on Saturday. Jan 21 teams will be re-pooled and re-seeded and have their own SAT bracket & Champion. 2-day Teams will be re-pooled and re-seeded and play their own bracket on Sunday. There will be (1) single day champion team and (1) multi-day champion team.
- **Up-refs will be provided for Pool Play on SAT and ONLY SUN's Bracket play matches.** Coaches will up-ref SAT's bracket play matches (single day teams).

● 13-14 Gold (1-day) Jan 21

- 1-day event played on SAT, registered with the Iowa Region as a Gold series event. Pool play and bracket play played out with a single team champion on the same day.

● 13-14 Qualifying (1-day) Jan 21

- 1-day event played on SAT, registered with the Iowa Region as a Qualifying series event for those teams potentially interested in being eligible to play in the Iowa Region Qualifier.
- Pool play and bracket play played out with a single team champion on the same day.

● 13-14s (up-refs provided)

- 2-day event played on SAT & SUN, registered with the Iowa Region as a Qualifying series event for those teams potentially interested in the Iowa Region Qualifier.
- Pool play matches on SAT and bracket play played out on Sunday with a single team champion.

● 15-16 Qualifying (1-day) Jan 21

- 1-day event played on SAT, registered with the Iowa Region as a Qualifying series event for those teams potentially interested in being eligible to play in the Iowa Region Qualifier.
- Pool play and bracket play played out with a single team champion.

● 15-16 Qualifying (1-day) Jan 22

- 1-day event played on SUN, registered with the Iowa Region as a Qualifying series event for those teams potentially interested in being eligible to play in the Iowa Region Qualifier.

● 17-18s (up-refs provided)

- 2-day event played on SAT & SUN, registered with the Iowa Region as a Qualifying series event for those teams potentially interested in being eligible to play in the Iowa Region Qualifier.
- Pool play matches on SAT & SUN and bracket play played out on Sunday following the conclusion of SUN's pool play matches. There will be a single team champion.

Pool Play & Bracket Play Procedures & Scoring

- **DO NOT BRING YOUR VOLLEYBALLS!** We will supply all warm-up volleyballs, carts, and game-balls for all teams and divisions.
- **Warm-Up Time:** Everyone's first match of the day will get a 2-4-4 warm-up time (2 mins shared, 4 mins serving team, 4 mins receiving team).
- **Pool Play Scoring:** All divisions will start at 0-0 and play 2 sets only during pool play to 25 points with NO CAP
- **Bracket Play Scoring:** Best 2 out of 3 (25-25-15) NO CAP
- There will be **NO switching sides for Pool Play and Bracket Play.**
- **All scores and results will be posted on AES as matches conclude.**
- **Pool Play Finishers and Tie-Breaker Protocol for seeding into Bracket Play**
 - **Set Wins**
 - **Head to Head Result (if applicable)**
 - **Head to Head Point Differential (if applicable)**
 - **Total Points in Pool Play**
- **We will play ahead as much as possible, keep track of your court and the match before you and have your team ready to play if matches end early.**
- **PM waves will NOT start before their allocated start time.**
- **DO NOT LEAVE THE TOURNAMENT until you have confirmed via AES or the tournament director that you have completed all reffing/work assignments.**
- Per USAV guidelines, Protests are permitted. Frank Flanagan will handle all protest issues outside of the 17-18s (2-day) division since he'll be coaching in that division as well. Any potential protests in the 17-18s (2-day division) will be handled by Assistant Tournament Director, Kelsay McCausland.
 - From the Iowa Region Championships Manual:
 - All rulings by the protest committee are final and not subject to appeal
 - No match will be allowed to proceed until the protest is settled
 - Only protests involving misinterpretation/misapplication of the playing rules, scoring, and incorrect sanction penalties will be accepted
 - Judgment calls are NOT subject to protest
