

Grayhound Volleyball Club Round Robin

Doors open at 7:45 a.m. Play starts at 8:30 a.m.

Admission/Seating:

Spectator admission will be \$3 per person. Kids 10 and under are free. Bleacher seating is available, no chairs please. Team camp area will be in the cafeteria. Spectators should stay clear of the bench and score table areas at all times. There will be NO SEATING in the first row of the lower bleachers.

Concessions:

We will NOT have a concession stand with hot food. We will only have a bake sale table and some snacks available for purchase. Sorry for the inconvenience.

Please feel free to bring coolers but NO plug-in appliances.

Format:

This tournament is a 5-team round robin format with NO BRACKET PLAY. Tournament champion on each court will be determined by pool champion (see schedule for criteria). Medals will be awarded to the 1st place team in each pool. 12U will play on Court 1. 13U will play on Court 2. We will play two games to 25 points, starting at 4-4, win by two points, with no cap.

IMPORTANT- WE WILL PLAY AHEAD OF SCHEDULE! With the five-team round robin format, there are plenty of breaks built into your schedule, so please be paying attention and ready to play as soon as the previous match has concluded.

Warmups:

For the first three matches of the day, the warm up time will be 2-4-4. 2 minutes shared, 4 minutes for the serving team, 4 minutes for the receiving team. Warmups for the first match of the day will start promptly at 8:20 a.m. There will be NO shared serving. In addition, per USAV rules, you are NOT ALLOWED to warm up off the court during the other teams net time. After the first three matches of the day, the warm up time will be 3-3 (3 minutes for the serving team, 3 minutes for the receiving team).

Team Information:

You must bring your own warm up balls. Balls are to be used in the GYM ONLY. No ball handling in the hallways or cafeteria.

You must bring an updated roster to turn in at check in. There will be no coaches meeting.

Officiating:

Officiating teams should be ready to call for captains within two minutes of the prior match concluding. Your team is responsible for providing their own whistles. If you officiate immediately after you play, please make sure that you have your players ready to go, and that everyone knows your schedule/assignments.

If a player is up officiating, a coach or certified adult needs to be standing next to them and overruling when deemed necessary. You MUST have a coach or certified adult working at the score table as well. Certified adults MUST be listed on your roster per USAV rules.

12U Specific Rules:

For 12U, we will use a Vollelylite game ball for play (we will provide this). The net height for 12U will be set at 7'. The service line will be a dashed blue line ("step-in line") 6'6" into the court. The out of bounds lines will remain the same.
